Veteran Pavers line the area around the monument. The Memorial is currently in storage during the renovation of our Community/Municipal Building.

As we plan to move back into 2829 when construction is complete, the Village would like to offer residents the opportunity to purchase a brick to be added when the Memorial is reinstalled.
